Conjunction of the Moon with Jupiter

Find the bright planet Jupiter in conjunction with the waxing gibbous Moon on the evening of May 27th. The full Moon occurs on May 29th.

The two solar system objects will appear to spend the night together, crossing the southern sky from east to west.

Even though Jupiter is just 19 days past “opposition”, closest to Earth for the year, it is still some 413 million miles behind the Moon!
