

October 2019 Sky Events

Four Planets and a very young new Moon at Twilight

Shortly after sunset on **October 29th**, look to the SW to see a very spectacular alignment of the planets Saturn, Jupiter, Venus and Mercury, along the ecliptic with an only 4.3% illuminated (1.9 days old), very slender, waxing crescent Moon.

Seek a view low to the SW horizon with binoculars to locate fainter Mercury, Venus and the Moon.

At its next “inferior conjunction” on Nov. 11th, [Mercury will transit across the disk of the Sun](#).
