Look W-SW after sunset for Venus – the brightest planet as seen from Earth. It'll look like an unusually bright “evening star”. It's climbing higher in the sky now, reaching [greatest elongation east](#) (46°) of the Sun on March 24th.

By May, with a telescope, you'll be able to see Venus wane to a thin crescent phase, shortly before it disappears into the sunset in June.
