

The Beaver Moon Joins Saturn and Jupiter

On the night of **November 10th**, the waxing crescent Beaver Moon “visits” the gas giant planets Saturn and Jupiter, in the constellation Capricornus, forming a triangular shape. This year the Beaver Moon is “full” on the night of Nov. 18/19.

Saturn and Jupiter are located some 937 million miles and 449 million miles, respectively, behind the Moon. Both planets are still in excellent position for telescopic observation.
