Dr. Jessica Noviello is an assistant research scientist at the University of Maryland Baltimore County and the NASA Goddard Space Flight Center. She earned her PhD from Arizona State University in 2019. Her research work ranges from asteroids to the habitability of Europa to the geophysics of Kuiper belt objects to the chemical composition of exoplanets.
